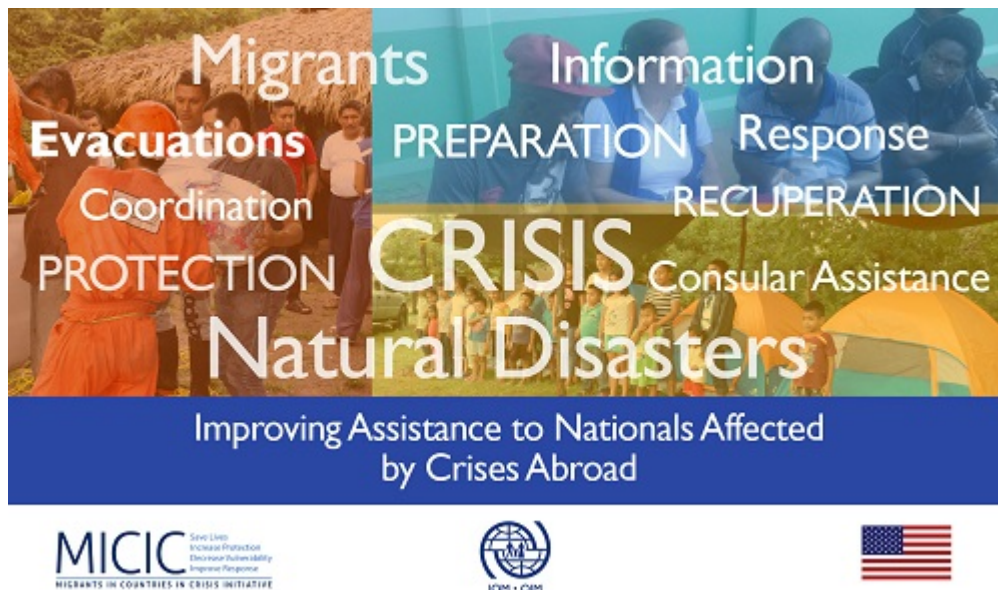

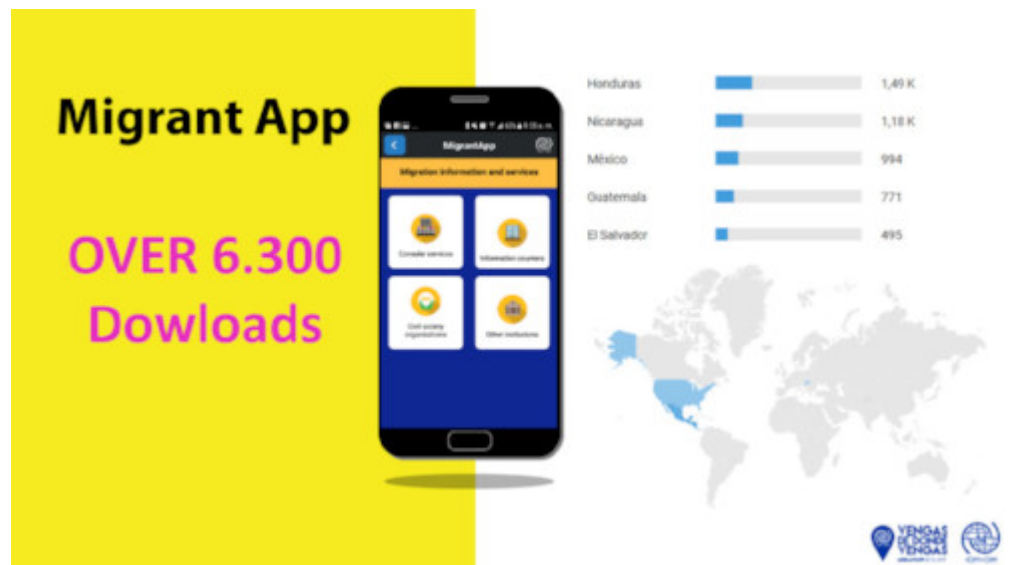
The member countries of the Regional Conference on Migration (RCM) met from the 27th to the 30th

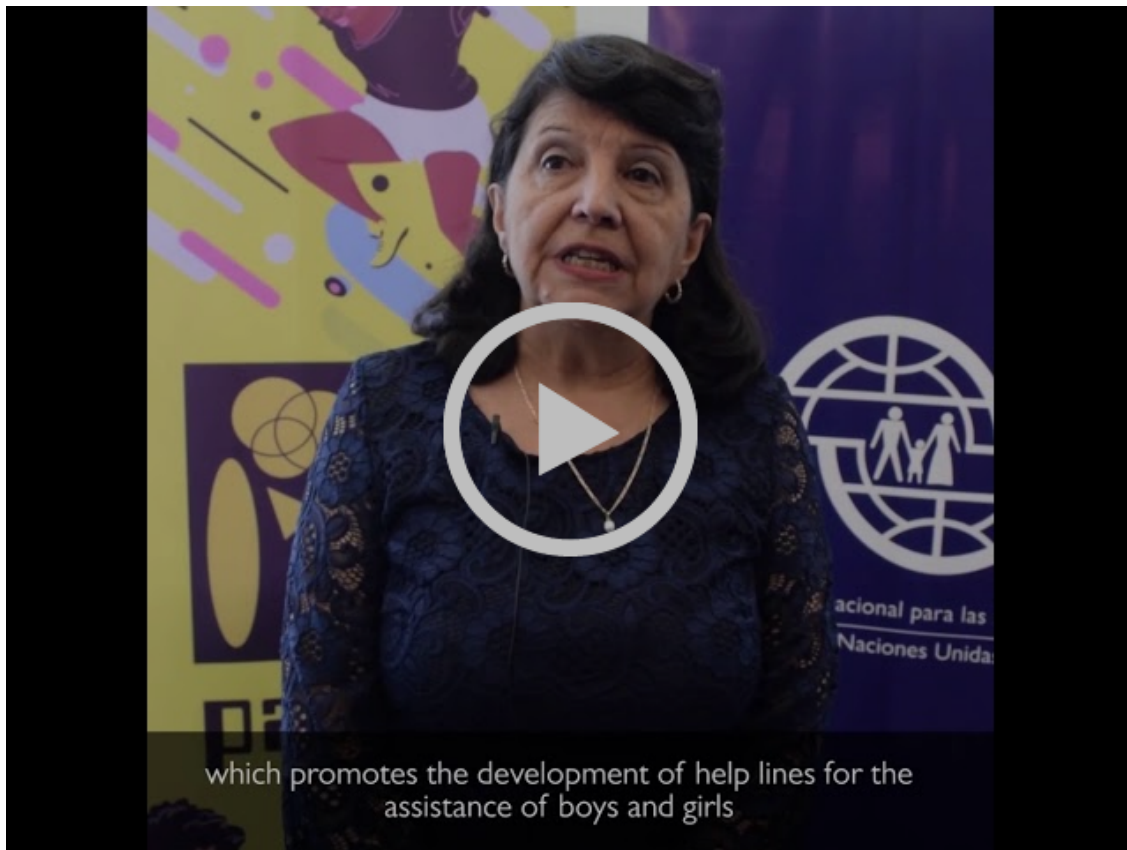

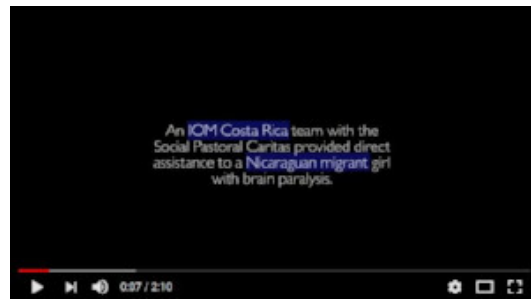
