Position Title:	Graphic Designer for Reports on Planned Relocation and Evacuations in the Caribbean.
Duty Station:	Remote. Work may be conducted off-site.
Type of Appointment:	Consultancy through September 10, 2021
Start Date:	July 5, 2021
End Date:	September 10, 2021, with deliverables due August 27, 2021

- 1. **Objective:** IOM seeks a qualified designer to illustrate, design and layout pieces for printed materials and to develop digital and printed products for two reports, one focused on planned relocation in the Caribbean and the other focused on evacuation policy and practice in the Caribbean. This activity is to be carried out under the management of the International Organization for Migration (IOM), under the Western Hemisphere Migration Program, funded by the United States Department of State Bureau of Population, Refugees, and Migration (PRM).
- 2. **IOM Project to which the consultancy is contributing:** Western Hemisphere Program, regional activities focused on planned relocation and evacuation.

General functions

- 3. Under the overall guidance of the Research Officer, Research Coordinator, and Western Hemisphere Program Support Officer for the Caribbean, the consultant's functions will include:
 - a. Creating the layout and related products of the study on planned relocation in the Caribbean, approximately 80 pages, in strict accordance with IOM publication and branding guidelines in both online and print formats;
 - **b.** Creating the layout and related products of the study on evacuations in the Caribbean, approximately 80 pages, in strict accordance with IOM publication and branding guidelines in both online and print formats;
 - **c.** Creative design and presentation of text, photos, graphics, and other elements within the reports;
 - **d.** Create the layout and design for two executive summaries of 2 pages each and an anticipated 9 briefs of 1-2 pages each
 - **e.** Design digital graphic materials for online presentation on websites, social media, or presentations;
 - **f.** Others as required.
