- Contribute to better migration management.

- Hold community and recreational activities as a means of communication.
- Respond to migration-related needs in the different countries in the region.
- Enable collection and updating of general information on migration trends and dynamics.
- Create comprehensive dialogue with the community, enabling negative stereotypes about migration to be overcome.
- Refer cases to competent governmental and nongovernmental institutions based on identified needs.
